## **Program Description**

Applicants must be full-time students at BYU.

The Ella Carpenter Jensen Fellowship has been established at BYU to provide financial support to women who wish to pursue graduate studies in any of the departments in the College of Family, Home, and Social Sciences.

The fellowship may amount up to \$2,000, although in the past several years smaller fellowships have been awarded. The money may be used for tuition or to fund a thesis or dissertation project. The fellowship may be renewable for a second year based on reasonable progress toward a degree.
