Program Description

Applicants must be full-time students at BYU.

The Beverley Nalder Scholarship has been established at BYU to provide financial support to single mothers who wish to pursue a graduate or undergraduate degree in the behavioral sciences and have at least a 3.3 GPA.

The scholarship will provide financial assistance to those single mothers in need of financial help. The money may be used towards tuition and/or textbooks. The scholarship may be renewable for a second year based on reasonable progress toward a degree and a continued need for financial assistance.
