This scholarship will provide financial assistance towards purchasing textbooks. The scholarship may be renewable for a second semester based on reasonable progress toward a degree.

For winter semester, applications are due by 5:00 P.M. on Thursday, October 15, 2009. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified by the end of November and funds will be available at the beginning of winter semester.
